


Sir,

With reference to the project cited above, you are requested to furnish the following documents to the Regional Office as per the Environmental Clearance issued:

- i. Final Environmental Impact Assessment report submitted for the grant of environmental clearance;
- ii. Project feasibility report submitted for the grant of Environmental clearance;
- iii. Final Layout Plan submitted for the grant of Environmental clearance;
- iv. Paper advertisement given regarding accord of Environmental Clearance; and
- v. Name and postal address of concerned Project Chief along with phone number/fax number/email id for further communication.

2. Further, It is requested that six monthly compliance reports along with the monitored data (both hard and soft copy in PDF format) as well as supporting documents duly signed by the Competent Authority (with name, designation and contact details) shall be submitted every year on 1st June (for the period 1st October to 31st March) and on 1st December (for the period 1st April to 30th September) to the address mentioned above. It is also requested that six monthly compliance reports may kindly be uploaded on the website of your company and periodically updated. In case of non-submission of six monthly compliance reports, Ministry would be constrained to take action as deemed fit under the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 without any further reference to the Unit.
