**CHARGE MEMO. ISSUED TO DR. C.C. PULLAIAH, M.S., C.S.S. IN ORTHOPAEDICS, E.S.I. HOSPITAL, ADONI.**

**No. 20.**

It has brought to the notice of the Government that Dr. C.C. Pullaiah, M.S., C.S.S. in Orthopaedics, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni has applied for leave from 16-12-93 to 4-1-94 and extended from 5-1-94 to 10-1-94, 11-1-94 to 11-2-94, 12-2-94 to 10-7-94, 11-7-94 to 11-10-94, 12-7-94 to 11-4-95, 12-4-95 to 11-10-95. In view of the



unauthorised absence from duty, the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni has compelled to refer all the Orthopaedic cases to Government General Hospital, Kurnool for treatment and lot of expenditure was incurred for the reimbursement of Medical Bills of Kurnool, besides causing much inconvenience to needy E.S.I. beneficiaries. The leave applied by the Medical officer was negated due to exigencies of services and directed to join duty immediately on pain of disciplinary action. He disobeyed the orders and continued under unauthorised absence from duty. Hence, he is liable for disciplinary action as per 4 P.C.S. (CCA) Rules and the following charges are framed against him:

#### Charge - I:

That he was under unauthorised absence from duty w.e.f. 16-12-93.

#### Ground of the Charge:

The Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni, has informed through his Lr. No. 652/E-1-93, Dt. 21-2-94 that Dr. C.C. Pullatah, M.S., C.S.S. in Orthopaedics has applied leave as follows:

- (i) From 16-12-93 to 4-1-94 received by the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni on 16-12-93.
- (ii) From 5-1-94 to 10-1-94 received by the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni on 26-1-94.
- (iii) From 11-1-94 to 11-2-94 received by the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni on 11-1-94.
- (iv) From 11-2-94 to 10-7-94 received by the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni on 19-2-94.
- (v) From 11-7-94 to 1-10-94 received by the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni on 27-7-94.
- (vi) From 12-7-94 to 11-4-95 applied on 12-2-95 received by the Superintendent, E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni on 4-3-95.
- (vii) From 12-4-95 to 10-10-95 received by the Director, Insurance Medical Services, A.P. Hyderabad on 10-9-95.

The Leave applied by the Medical Officer was refused due to exigencies of services and directed him to join duty on pain of disciplinary action. He has never obtained prior permission before applying leave from the Competent authority. Rule 67 of F.R. reads that leave cannot be claimed as a right when the exigencies of the Public Services so require, discretion to refuse or revoke leave of any description is reserved to the authority empowered to grant it. Hence, he has disobeyed the orders of higher authority and continued under unauthorised absence upto 20-2-96.

#### Charge-2:

Dislocation of Medical Care at E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni.

#### Ground of the Charge:

The unauthorised absence of the Medical Officer has caused much difficulty in Orthopaedics wing at E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni. In his absence, all the Orthopaedic cases are being referred to Government General Hospital, Kurnool for treatment and lot of expenditure incurred for their reimbursement of Medical Bills of Kurnool. Further Medical care towards E.S.I. Beneficiaries effected badly as they have to travel all the way from E.S.I. Hospital, Adoni to Government General Hospital, Kurnool, as the Orthopaedics Department is very essential to the I.Ps.

Dr. C.C. Pullatah, M.S., C.S.S. is therefore, directed to submit his written statement of defence, if any, as to why disciplinary action should not be taken against him for his unauthorised absence within 30 days from the date of receipt of this Memo. Failing which it will be construed that he has no representation to make and action will be taken based on the material available on the record.
