PETITION UNDER SECTION 32 (1) OF THE A.P. (TA) TENANCY AND AGRICULTURAL LANDS ACT, 1950

The Petitioners humbly submit as follows:

That late Sri Variloppula Ramaiah was the protected tenant over the land bearing Survey No.37 situated at Begumpet Village. During his life time he enjoyed the properties in the capacity of protected tenant. Late Sri Varikoppula Ramaiah had two wives viz. Durgamma, the petitioner No.2 herein and Narasamma. The petitioner No.2 was the first wife through h whom the petitioner No.1 got the snly the son while he had two sons viz. Laxman and Yadagiri through his second wife Smt. Narasamma. is submitted that the petitioners herein stayed away from Begumpet and lived at Kamareddy to ekeout the livelyhood, after the demise of Varikoppula Ramaiah. that during the continious absence of the petitioners at Begumpet, Sri Laxman and Sri \* Yadagiri who are the sons of second wife got succession of protected tenancy rights keeping in dark the petitioner herein and when the petitioners by late came to know that Sri Laxman and Sri Yadagiri got P.T. rights over the above said suit lands, the petitioners filed petition before the Mandal Revenue Officer, Balanagar

decemendants of the late Varikoppula Ramaiah and requested to grant succession in favour of the petitioners. The Mandal Revenue Officer Balanagar granted succession in favour of the petitioners in the rights of protected tenancy and other half share in favour of Laxman and Yadagiri, since Smt. Narasamma also since died, as per the mutual undertstanding between petitioners herein and Laxman and Yadagiri, the step-brothers of petitioner No.1.

That it is submitted that Sri Laxman and Sri Yadagiri have vobuntary relinqueshed their half share of rights of protected tenancy in Sy. No. 37 of Begumpet in tavour of the petitioners herein and also executed Release Deed to that effect. The petitioners thereofre again approach the Mandal Revenue Officer, Balanagar by filling petition under Section 40 of the said Act, to declare them andxgr to grant succession only in favour of the petitioner herein and the Mandal Revenue Officer. Balanagar was pleased to declare the petitioners alone as a legal heirs to succeed and for the declaration as a protected tenance devolved and unto them by way of in hertence and passed orders dated 19-03-1993 in Case No.B/3/93. Hence the petitioners alone and possess absolute protected tenancy rights over the above suit lands. It is submitted that consequenty to relinquishedent of half share by Sri Laxman and Sri Yadagiri, they have handed over physical possession of the land bearing Sy.No.37 of Begumpet in favour of the petitioners herein and thus the petitioners held physical possession and enjoyment of the suit land, as on date.

That it is submitted that the respondent under
the guise of some documents said to have been purchased by
him is contemplating to dispossess the petitioners forceably.
It is submitted that a land which is covered by the
protected tenancy can not be purchased by any third person
and any such sale or purchase are void within the ampit
of the tenancy Act., therefore any transaction between the
original Pattadar and any person including the respondent
is illegal and any such transaction is not binding upon
the petitioner. The respondent likely to dispossess the
petitioners any time by using the force of unsocial elements
which may cause the petitioner irreperable loss and damage,
in case the respondent successed in his evil efforts to

It is therefore prayed that the Hon'ble Mandal Revenue Officer, Balanagar, Ranga Reddy District may be pleased to grant injunction against the respondent, his agents and any third parties, restraining them from interference with the petitioners from their uninterrprated and peaceful possession and enjoyment of the suit land bearing Sy.No.37 of Begumpet Village, in the interest of justice.
