

Today is Sunday the 13th March, 2005, 1630 Hrs. Obviously you heard about the damage on the rear side of our house. I am e-mailing several pictures taken this morning, if you care to know the kind of severe life hazard this has posed to my family.

This happened at about 2AM last night while my father-in-law was asleep in the bedroom in the rear, behind which the boulders slipped and crashed onto the window and the whole rear bedroom.

First of all: Two weeks ago my wife brought this to the attention of Francis and your security guard Shanker that the wall on the rear had cracked by merely sand that was dumped by the builders behind. She reminded him again about this 1 week ago. Your employees merely shrugged at it in a typical manner which we have come to recognize as something that they don't consider serious. However, as we have realized from the past few experiences (when the drain was leaking behind, or the window in the bedroom just gave way and many other smaller incidents) your company and its employees need to be reminded more than twice about anything before you spring to action, and when they do, it is in the most lackadaisical manner. Since your people did not warn the builder behind, they obviously carried out their construction work by continuing the building and placing rocks on a wall that could not hold even a truck load of sand. So, this was an accident waiting to happen.

Secondly: Last nights dangerous event was MOST unsettling and very disturbing to all of us!! Especially to a) my father in law who was sleeping in the bedroom below and b) to our domestic live-in aid who uses the bathroom in the rear. If this had happened during the day at any time while she or my wife

could have been drying the clothes, this could have proved fatal to anyone there!!!! IF the servant had even used the bathroom in the rear last night, just as this damage occurred, she could have been trapped and probably died!!!!!!! Fortunately the Live-in aid sleeps inside the house. if she had been using the room behind to sleep, she would surely be trapped!

There are many scenarios' one can imagine and I am not here to discuss that.

The bedroom in the rear has a crack! This is most unnerving to us and is dangerous!!!! I demand that you have a civil engineer sent IMMEDIATELY to the premises and have this checked. Francis looking at it is meaningless! A CE needs to make an assessment of the bedroom whether it is safe to inhabit. And if he says it is safe, i would like a written certification from this engineer or Modi properties that the bedroom is safe and you will carry out all necessary repairs IMMEDIATELY WITHOUT DELAY.

This is simply outrageous! I have a good mind to e-mail all these pictures to the local newspapers. The more i think of this and see the damage, the more mind boggling it is. You have to take the builder of the building to task for this outlandish negligence creating a dangerous situation for us living here. This is also gross negligence on your part!!!

I am most unhappy living here with these countless episodes of negligence and shoddy repair work for every little thing. Needless to say that we will take note of any damage to our personal belongings as a result of this and advise your office of it with its cost. Your staff was warned about this potential hazard and they took no cognizance of this or perhaps did not even care to bring this to your attention. It reflects badly on you and your company that you manage!

I certainly expect to hear from you personally on Monday. This is the least i expect from the company i am paying my monthly rent to!
