



- (b) The R.C.C. slabs shall be so laid that claims of the drain shall be easily affected and the same shall not be chocked or blocked in whatsoever manner.
- (c) The distance between one slab and another shall not be much as to endanger the pedestrians or passersby.
- (d) The first part shall have ~~only~~ only a right of access and passage over the drain so covered to a length of 340ft. to reach the ring road and shall have no other right either internal or external, on the drainage line or any part thereof.
- (e) The first part shall not have any right of claim back the R.C.C. slabs so laid at any time infuture including right to claim any compensation, when the other portion of the drainage line is sought to be covered similarly by the corporation at its expense.
- (f) The Commissioner or his nominee shall have authority to inspect and order for repairs and maintenance, if so warranted, to the drainage line covered to a length of 340ft. to ensure free flow of sullage water.
- (g) ~~The Commissioner shall also have authority to order for widening or improving the existing open drainage line now sought to be covered with R.C.C. slabs, for better utilisation of the same by the residents of the locality including the first part mentioned herein above and the first part shall have no objection whatsoever, as such improvement shall be to his advantage as well.~~

You have failed to provide adequate number of man holes, ladder for the Municipal Drainage Workers to enter the drain for cleaning.

ORDER:

Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner and the learned Standing Counsel for the Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad.

An agreement dated March 23, 1968 was entered into between the petitioner and the respondent—Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad as to the maintenance of a drain of a length of 340 feet, situated behind the premises of the petitioner at Karbala Maidan, Secunderabad. In the impugned notice dated October, 8, 1987 issued by the Municipal Corporation of Hyderabad, Secunderabad division, it was stated that the petitioner failed to provide adequate number of manholes and ladder for the Municipal Drainage workers to enter the drain for cleaning. It was also stated that it was proposed to keep the drain open to sky to avoid poisonous gases that would be formed on account of covering the open drain. The petitioner was asked to provide alternative arrangements within 10 days from the date of receipt of that notice. Questioning the validity of that notice this writ petition is filed.

It is submitted by the learned counsel for the petitioner that as per the terms and conditions of the agreement entered into between the petitioner and the Municipal Corporation, the petitioner covered the drain with R.C. C. slabs with sufficient number of manholes and he did not, in any way, violate the conditions of the agreement. On the other hand, it is submitted by the learned Standing Counsel for the Municipal Corporation that as stated in the notice dated October 8, 1987 the petitioner failed to provide adequate number of man-holes and ladder for the Municipal Drainage Workers to enter the drain for cleaning. It was further stated that the manholes provided were narrow for the workers to enter the drain to clean and it was proposed to keep the drain open to sky to avoid poisonous gases that would be formed on account of covering of the open drain. It is contended that the matter pertains to the realm of contractual obligation and therefore the writ petition is not maintainable.

I do not think that it would be proper for this court at this stage to express a view one way or the other on the merits of the case. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is directed to submit his explanation to the notice dated October 8, 1987 within two weeks from today. On receipt of the explanation, the Municipal Corporation shall pass appropriate orders in

Further to our objections dt.27.10.87 we have to inform you that we filed Writ Petition No.16232/87 questioning your show cause notice proposing to remove the RCC Slabs over the drain in our premises. The High Court was pleased to dispose of the Writ Petition on 30.10.87 with a direction to us to file objections before you within 2 weeks. Further the High Court ordered that you shall consider the objections and pass appropriate orders in accordance with law and that the final order if any passed by you should not be implemented, till 2 weeks after passing of the order.

A copy of the High Court order is enclosed herewith. We accordingly submit our objections as under:-

1. Having entered into agreement with us pursuant to the permission granted under Section 299(1) of the H.M.C. Act, the Honourable Commissioner cannot revoke the agreement in the absence of any breach of the terms of the agreement by us. As already submitted, there has been no breach of any of the terms of the agreement whatsoever and the officials of Municipal Corporation, Hyderabad have never brought to our notice any such breach all these years during any of their inspections. Thus the impugned notice is without jurisdiction, and is contrary to the proceedings dt.25.01.88 issued by the Municipal Corporation.

2. Even assuming that the Honourable Commissioner can revoke permission granted under section 299(1) of the H.M.C. Act, it is not open to him to

revoke the permission granted as early as in 1968 by virtue of the principle of estoppel in as much as the petitioner has acted upon it and spent about Rs. 2 lakhs to its detriment.

3. The impugned notice is arbitrary and unreasonable and caused hardship to us since, as already submitted we have spent about 2 lakhs in 1968. If the drain is kept open ourselves including our tenants will not have any access to their premises from the Ring Road. Further a lot of refuse will be dumped into the drain and there is also risk of its being used as latrine by the General Public. Besides emanating foul smell it will become a health hazard to the workers of our tenants and to the General public. We request you kindly to obtain opinion of any Medical expert as to whether the covering the drain is an advisable act.

4. The impugned notice is also contrary to section 316 of the M.N.C. Act under which it is mandatory on the part of the Corporation to cover all the open drains whether belonging to the Corporation or to private persons. In fact in all modern cities and towns all over the world, drainage system is covered in the interest of public health. By keeping it open, there will be lot of mosquito nuisance endangering the health of the public.

5. Further the agreement does not provide that we should construct man holes much less provide ladders. Not with standing this, we have provided 4 man holes to facilitate occasional cleaning of the drain.

6. Further the corporation itself has raised basic structure for a commercial complex completely sealing the same drain running through the adjacent premises and we wonder why we are required to open up RCC slabs which are only helping us to have an access to our premises through the ring road.

7. The Honourable Commissioner will also appreciate that if the drain is open to sky, it will affect the health of the workers and it will also make an ugly sight on an important ring road which connects the developing sanjounish park and is also the road popularly used for going to Air port.

8. In the circumstances we request you to continue the agreement and to have the RCC slabs over the drain and deny your proposal to remove them. We request you also arrange for joint inspection of the site on any date suitable to you. In case you wish to proceed further, please give us an opportunity of presenting hearing as directed by the Honourable High Court.

Incidentally we inform you that your squad had hastily acted on 11.11.57 and commenced demolishing of the RSI slabs inspite of our intimating them about the High Court order by 1.00 pm and also producing a copy of the acknowledgement given in your office at 1.30 pm. The demolition continued till 3.45 pm on 11.11.57 and could be stopped with great difficulty. Please note that these objections are filed by us without prejudice to our right to take appropriate legal action for claiming damages for the act done by the corporation and also to take action against such of the officials who failed to acknowledge and obey the High Court order.

Further the High Court ordered that you shall consider the objections and pass appropriate orders in accordance with Law and that the final order if any passed by you should not be implemented, till 2 weeks after passing of the order.

A copy of the High Court order is enclosed herewith. We accordingly submit our objections as under:-

1. Having entered into agreement with us pursuant to the permission granted under Section 299(1) of the M.M.C. Act, the Honourable Commissioner cannot revoke the agreement in the absence of any breach of the terms of the agreement by us. As already submitted, there has been no breach of any of the terms of the agreement whatsoever and the officials of Municipal Corporation Hyderabad have never brought to our notice any such breach all these years during any of their inspections. Thus the impugned notice is without jurisdiction, and is contrary to the proceedings dt. 23.08.86 issued by the Municipal Corporation.
2. Even assuming that the Honourable Commissioner can revoke permission granted under section 299(1) of the M.M.C. Act, it is not open to him to revoke the permission granted as early as in 1986 by virtue of the principle of estoppel in as much as the petitioner has acted

upon it and spent about Rs.35,000/- to its detriment.

3. The impugned notice is arbitrary and unreasonable and caused hardship to us since, as already submitted we have spent about Rs.35,000/- in 1968. If the drain is kept open, ourselves including our tenants will not have any access to their premises from the Ring Road. Further a lot of refuse will be dumped into the drain and there is also risk of its being used as latrine by the General public. Besides emanating foul smell it will become a health hazard to the workers of our tenants and to the General Public. We request you kindly to obtain opinion of any Medical expert as to whether un-covering the drain is an advisable act.
4. The impugned notice is also contrary to Section 316 of the M.M.C. Act under which it is mandatory on the part of the Corporation to cover all the open drains whether belonging to the Corporation or to private persons. In fact, in all the modern cities and towns all over the world, drainage system is covered in the interest of public health. By keeping it open there will be a lot of mosquito menace endangering the health of the public.
5. Further the Corporation itself has raised basic structure for a commercial complex completely sealing the same drain running through the adjacent premises and we wonder why we are required to open up RCC Slabs which are only helping us to have an access to our premises through the ring road.
6. The Honourable Commissioner will also appreciate that if the drain is open to sky, it will affect the health of the workers and it will also make an ugly sight on an important ring road which connects the developing Sanjeeviah Park and is also the road popularly used for going to the Air Port.
7. In the circumstances we request you to continue the agreement and to have the RCC Slabs over the drain and drop your proposal to remove them. We request you also to arrange for joint inspection of the site on any date suitable to you. In case you wish to proceed further, please give us an opportunity of personal hearing as directed by the Honourable High Court.

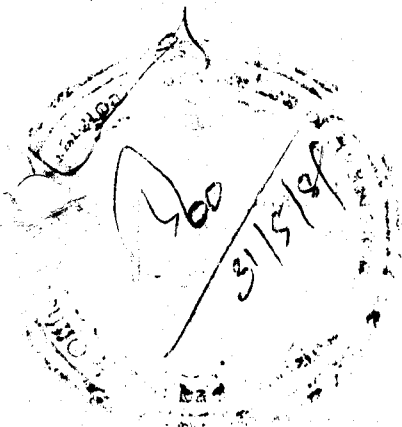




