- 1. Lumpsum rate for turnkey RCC work including centering and rod bending shall be Rs. 60/- per sft on the super built-up area mentioned in the brochure i.e., for bungalow types B, D & A, C.
- 2. The guideline schedule of work shall be as follows:
  - a. Starting from the date of laying the PCC the plinth beams should be completed within two weeks.
