- 3. Thirdly, by executing the agreement with Builder, we have not derived any wrongful gain. The same security deposit & monthly rental would have been paid by us to the Association, had the agreement been executed with the Association.
- 4. There is enormous delay in filing the complaint.
- 5. This is essentially Civil Nature in dispute.
