Along with you, so many other industries of Azamabad Industrial area questioned the Constitutional Validity of the above Act by way of writ petition in High Court of A.P., and had obtained stay till the disposal of the writ petitions. After hearing for nearly two weeks, the Division Bench of the High Court dismissed the entire batch of writ petitions by the Judgement delivered on 18th Aug., 1994. Therefore there is no more stay. I have talked to Mr. G. Ramaswamy, Senior Advocate of Supreme Court & Former Attorney General. On behalf of all the writ petitioners I want to engage him. However there will be high expenses for Supreme Court. You should be ready for incurring the expenditure which will be informed to you by me after ~~through~~ ^{thorough} discussion with Mr. Ramaswamy.

In the meanwhile I am of opinion that you should submit an application with the competent Authority under the act for grant of fresh lease, clearly mentioning therein that the application is made without prejudice to your

rights of moving the matter to the Supreme Court of India and obtaining stay order. Otherwise some other persons may apply for lease and the competent authority may assume that you are not interested in applying for fresh lease.

I request ~~to~~ you to be kind enough to contact me after 10 days for further steps. By that time I will be able to obtain the copy of the High Court Judgement.
