Dear Sir,

This is to record the arrangement arrived at between us regarding the sanction for the factory plan submitted to the Hyderabad Municipal Corporation.

I learn that the corporation is charging extremely high fees at the rate Rs.2/- per sq.ft. for sanctioning the plan. I understand that some parties have filed writ petitions challenging fees charged by the corporation and the petition has been admitted. It is likely that I may have to give a Bank Guarantee instead of making payment to the corporation.

I request you to authorise me to file a writ petition in your name as your constituted Attorney. I or my firm will bear all the cost, charges and expenses in respect of the writ petition proposed to be filed in your name challenging the fees demanded by the corporation.

I further assure you that I and my firm will keep you indemnified against ~~any~~ any damage or loss caused to you for any cost, charges or expenses that may be sought to be recovered from you in relation to the petition proposed to be filed in the High Court at Hyderabad and matters incidental thereto.

I am also forwarding a 4 Vakalatnamas in favour of M/s. M. Jagannadha Rao, M. Krishna Mohan Rao and M. Jagannadha Sarma.

I am also forwarding herewith draft of the special Power of Attorney which you may kindly execute and return to me at an early date.
