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We had made an application for allotment of foot ball ground in plot No.15/1& 15/2 Industrial area, Azamabad, which were allotted to welfare centre of labour department which are not in use for our proposed industry. Our request was favourably considered both by Industries department and labour welfare department. A joint inspection of the premises was carried out and we were asked to bear the cost of alternative welfare centre and the land to be allotted by infra structure corporation. We have given our consent to bear the cost.

We are now approaching the Government to expediate the ^{decision} discussion in this regard so that we can commence our work. Considerable time has passed in this process and we feel that it is necessary to make this representation before your good self to expediate the process and get a favourable ^{decision} discussion in

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this regard.

We are enclosing copy of our original application with our credential certificates and some of the correspondence of your ready ~~respon~~ reference.

Recently our partner Shri. Mahesh K. Desai who was the member in standardisation committee of hand pumps with Indian Standard institution was selected as an expert on rural water supply, as a member of trade delegation. Such trade delegation was accepted to be sent in Harare meeting by our Prime Minister.

Accordingly high level contact in all the member country has already been established and we have agreed to invite trainees for putting up the bore well programme in these countries. The paper submitted by M.K. Desai on the subject was also highly acclaimed in various countries and translated in several languages. The appropriate tempo has now been generated and it is an opportune time to implement what has been proposed since long. We are sure Government will support and encourage our enthusiasum and zeal to take up the project in which several years of hard work has gone in.

We request you sir to get the relevant facts and stage of our case both from Industries department and labour department and do the needful to allot us the plot requested for and oblige.
