ORDER

Learned counsel for the state of Andhra Pradesh has fairly stated that the impugned judgment of the High Court dated August 18, 1994 passed in writ petition No. 12235/94 and connected matter shall not be implemented. It is further stated that no action against the industries operating in the industrial area concerned shall be taken under the Andhra Pradesh Industrial Area Termination and Regulation of Leases Act, 1992 (The Act). We are further told that the State Govt. is proposing an amendment to the act. It is stated that the proposal has already been placed before the cabinet. Learned counsel states that no action regarding revocation of leases etc. against the industries concerned shall be taken under the act. In this view of the matter these appeals are become infructuous and are disposed of as such.
