The Court made the following:

ORDER:

This writ petition is filed for a writ of mandamus to declare that the leases in favour of the petitioners in respect of industrial plots situated in Azamabad Industrial Area, Hyderabad are subsisting and the petitioners are, therefore, entitled to opt for freehold rights over the said plots on payment of price and to declare demand notices, dated 03.06.2002, whereby the petitioners were called upon to pay the enhanced premium and quit rent with retrospective effect from 1985, as arbitrary, illegal and ultra vires the powers of the respondents.

On 21.10.2008, when this case came up for hearing, the learned Assistant Government Pleader placed before this Court letter No.13/1/2002/0028/FB, dated 01.05.2004 addressed by the Commissioner of Industries to the President, Azamabad Industries Association, Azamabad, wherein it is informed that the Government has taken a decision to convert the leasehold rights into freehold rights at 75% of the market value which was prevalent in February, 2000 and also to extend certain concessions. It is stated in

the said letter that the Government vide memos, dated 22.11.2003 and 03.02.2004 clarified that the Commissioner of Industries is authorized to and collect such quit rent and premium, which is not disputed in any Court of law prevailing up to 1983 till the freehold rights to the lessees as conferred are given. On the basis of the said proceedings, the Commissioner temporarily withdrew the impugned demand
