**ORDER:-**(per Hon'ble Sri Justice **P.SAM KOSHY**)

The instant writ petition has been filed seeking for a writ of mandamus to be issued directing the respondents to consider the representation filed by the petitioner dated 18.01.2023 for condonation of delay on their part in filing of From 10-IC for the assessment year 2021-2022.

- **2.** Heard Sri Peri Prabhakar, learned counsel for the petitioner and Smt. B. Sapna Reddy, learned counsel for the respondents-Department.
- **3.** On the previous date of hearing, this Court had directed the learned counsel for the respondents-Department to seek instructions, as to whether, the application/representation seeking for condonation of

delay in filing of From 10-IC is still pending consideration before the respondent No.1.

- 4. Today, the learned counsel for the respondentsDepartment submits that upon instructions, she has
  been infomed that the said application/representation
  seeking for condonation of delay in filing of From 10-IC is
  still pending consideration before the respondent No.1.
  It has been further informed that the said application
  shall be considered in accordance with law at the
  earliest.
- **5.** Given the said facts and submissions made by the learned counsel for the respondents-Department that the said application is pending consideration before the respondent No.1, the writ petition at this juncture, stands disposed of directing the respondents to ensure that a decision is made on the application filed by the petitioner on 18.01.2023 seeking condonation of delay in filing of Form 10-IC at the earliest, preferably within a outer limit of four (4) months from the date of reciept of a
