#### Circular Memo No.94/TSPCB/Categorisation/HO/2016 ~ 93

Date: 16.04.2016

Sub:	TSPCB - CPCB directions under section 18(1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 regarding harmonization of classification of industrial sectors under Red / Orange / Green / White Categories.— Instructions — Issued - Reg.
Ref:	CPCB directions vide B-29012/ESS(CPA)/2015/16, dt. 07.03.2016.

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It is to inform that vide reference cited above, the Central Pollution Control Board issued directions under 18(1) (b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 regarding classification of industrial sectors. The CPCB has communicated the Revised Classification of Industrial Sectors under Red, Orange, Green and White categories. The CPCB issued the following directions on 07.03.2016 while withdrawing earlier directions issued in June 2012 on categorisation of industries:

- The SPCBs and PCCs shall adopt the Revised Criteria of categorization of industrial sectors as detailed in table nos. F1, F2, F3 and F4 and revised Lists of Red, Orange, Green and White categories of industrial sectors, presented as table no G2, G3, G4 and G5 respectively
- All pending applications for consideration of 'Consent to Establish' and 'Consent to Operate' and future such applications shall be processed as per revised criteria.
- 3. The SPCBs and PCCs will provide the list of industries identified in each category existing in the State which have been considered for grant of consents. SPCBs/PCCs will forward the list of such industries before 31.05.2016 and the same will be uploaded on the websites of respective SPCB/PCC.
- 4. The 'Revised Lists of Red, Orange, Green and White category of industrial sectors' shall be used by the SPCBs and PCCs for Consent Management and inventorization of industries under Red, Orange, Green and White categories. Siting of industries shall be only in conforming areas. SPCBs / PCCs shall evolve sector specific plans for control of pollution and industrial surveillance for verifying compliance.
- 5. The SPCBs and PCCs shall revise / prepare the inventory of Red, Orange, Green and White categories of industries operating in their jurisdiction based on the revised criteria specified in the Final Report and submit the same to CPCB within 90 days i.e., before 30.05.2016 in hard copy as well as soft copy.
- The listed category of industries or those identified later-on under different categories shall not be linked to sanction of loan/finance or bank proceedings.

7. Any further addition of any new or left-over industrial sector and their categorization which is not listed in the revised list of Red, Orange, Green and White industrial sectors, shall be done at the level of concerned SPCB / PCC following revised criteria & guidelines as detailed in the attached document and no concurrence of CPCB shall normally be required. It is further clarified that white categorization the industries, fractional numbers shall be rounded off to nearest integer.

White category industries do not require to obtain consents of the Board and an intimation to the concerned Regional Officer, TSPCB shall suffice.

In view of the above, all the Unit Heads, Zonal Officers and Regional Officers are directed to implement the CPCB directions with immediate effect. All the Zonal Officers and Regional officers are directed to submit revised lists of industries of Red, Orange, Green and White categories duly following the revised classification of CPCB within 30 days.

All the ROs shall appraise the GMs, District Industries Centre, Industry Associations and other stake holders about the reclassification of industries.

TSPCB – Categorization of Industrial Sectors – CPCB Directions to the SPCBs Dt. 12.01.2021 to adopt and implement categorization of Building & Construction projects, Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste processing Plants and Gold Assaying & Hallmarking Centres as finalized by CPCB – Instructions Issued – Reg.

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The Central Pollution Control Board, Delhi vide reference 1<sup>st</sup> cited issued directions dated 07.03.2016 to all State Pollution Control Boards, under Section 18(1)(b) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 18(1) (b) of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 to comply with the recategorization of industries under Red, Orange, Green and White Categories.

The Board vide reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited issued Circular dated 16.04.2016 directing all the ROs, ZOs and Divisional Heads at Head office to implement the CPCB directions dated 07.03.2016 on new categorization of industries with immediate effect.

Subsequently, the CPCB vide order dt. 30.04.2020 issued directions to adopt and implement the categorization finalized by CPCB for Scrapping Centres, Used Cooking Oil (UCO) collection centers, Compressed/Refined Bio-Gas Production from Bio-degradable Wastes, Railway Stations. Accordingly, the Board vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited issued Circular dated 19.05.2020 directing all the ROs, ZOs and Divisional Heads at Head office to implement the same.

The CPCB vide order dt. 10.07.2020 issued directions to adopt and implement the categorization finalized by CPCB for Dairy Farm and Gaushala. The Board vide reference 6<sup>th</sup> cited issued Circular dated 28.07.2020 directing all the ROs, ZOs and Divisional Heads at Head office to implement the same.

Subsequently, as per recommendations of the Categorization Committee, the Board categorized certain additional activities / industries which were not covered under CPCB categorization and issued Circulars dated 30.09.2020 and 23.10.2020 directing all the ROs, ZOs and Divisional Heads at Head office to implement the same.

The CPCB vide order dt. 12.01.2021 issued directions to all SPCBs & PCCs to adopt and implement the categorization finalized by CPCB for Building & Construction projects, Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste processing Plants and Gold Assaying & Hallmarking Centres as follows:

Non-industrial operation	Category	Remarks
Building & Construction projects having built-up area up to 20,000 m2 and waste water ≥ 50 KLD	Orange	<ul> <li>i. Waste water is generated due to domestic use.</li> <li>ii. Projects having overall waste water generation of 50 KLD or more are considered for categorization. However, projects having waste water generation &lt;50 KLD are also required to treat/manage sewage with appropriate systems such as soak pit, septic tank, STP etc. or direct discharge into sewer connected with terminal STP etc., as per the prescribed guidelines/norms.</li> <li>iii. If the discharge ≥ 100 KLD, it will have the</li> </ul>
		normalized score (pollution index) of 75 and hence, be categorized as Red.
Construction & Demolition (C&D) waste Processing Plants	Orange	i. It Is mainly air polluting process / activities.  ii. Air pollution score is normalized to 100.  iii. Waste water of high TDS of inorganic nature is generated in wet processing units.  iv. In case of ancillary units/operations such as manufacturing of tiles, bricks, blocks etc., are associated, the categorization may change, depending on the process and waste generation.
Gold Assaying & Hallmarking Centres	Orange	<ul> <li>i. There is no waste water generation from the process.</li> <li>ii. Lead oxide, nitrous fumes are generated during cupellation and parting acid treatment, respectively contributing to the air emissions.</li> <li>iii. The hazardous waste is generated during fire assay in the form of spent cupels bearing lead, spent acid, scrubbed eater etc. This HW is required to disposed at TSDFs.</li> <li>iv. All the Gold Assaying &amp; Hallmarking Test Centres certified by BIS shall follow the "Environmental Guidelines for Gold Assaying and Hallmarking Centres", issued by CPCB.</li> </ul>

The revised lists of categories incorporating the above mentioned new sectors and CPCB directions dt. 12.01.2021 are being uploaded in the Board's website.

In view of the above, all ROs, ZOs & Divisional Heads at Head Office are directed to implement the above categorization with immediate effect.
