## SCHEDULE - A

- 1. The applicant shall make applications through online for renewal of Consent (under Water & Air Acts) and Authorization under HWM Rules at least 120 days before the date of expiry of this order, along with prescribed fee under Water and Air Acts for obtaining Consent & HW Authorization of the Board. The applicant can also apply for Auto Renewal of the CFO atleast 30 days before the expiry of this order as per the procedure and eligibility stipulated in the Board Circular dt.19.11.2015 & 08.12.2015 (available in Board's Website: <a href="http://tspcb.cgg.gov.in/Pages/Circulars.aspx">http://tspcb.cgg.gov.in/Pages/Circulars.aspx</a>).
- 2. Concealing the factual data or submission of false information/ fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned in this order may result in withdrawal of this order and attract action under the provisions of relevant pollution control Acts.
- 3. The industry may explore the possibility of tapping the solar energy for their energy requirements.
- 4. Any person aggrieved by an order made by the State Board under Section 25, Section 26, Section 27 of Water Act, 1974 or Section 21 of Air Act, 1981 may within thirty days from the date on which the order is communicated to him, prefer an appeal as per Rules, to such authority (hereinafter referred to as the Appellate Authority) constituted under Section 28 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 31 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.
- 5. The Board reserves its right to modify above conditions or stipulate any further conditions and to take action including revoke of this order in the interest of protection of public health and environment.

#### **SCHEDULE - B**

## **Special Conditions:**

1. The industry shall take steps to reduce water consumption to the extent possible and consumption shall NOT exceed the quantities mentioned below:

- 2. In case of any drawl of ground water, the industry shall apply and obtain NOC from CGWA within One month and submit a copy of the same at TSPCB Regional Office, Medchal.
- 3. The industry shall comply with emission limits for DG sets upto 800 KW as per the Notification G.S.R.520 (E), dated 01.07.2003 under the Environment (Protection) Amendment Rules, 2003 and G.S.R.448(E), dated 12.07.2004 under the Environment (Protection) Second Amendment Rules, 2004. In case of DG sets more than 800 KW shall comply with emission limits as per the Notification G.S.R.489 (E), dated 09.07.2002 at serial no.96, under the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 4. The industry should comply with the National ambient air quality standards as per MoEF, GoI notification dated. 18.11.2009 along the premises of the factory as prescribed below:

Noise Levels: Day time (6 AM to 10 PM) - 75 dB (A) Night time (10 PM to 6 AM) - 70 dB (A).

5. The industry shall manufacture only consented products and shall produce within the consented capacities. Under no circumstances, the industry shall manufacture any unconsented products without obtaining CFE & CFO of the Board.

- 6. The industry shall not provide pilot plant activity and shall not go for commercial production without permission of the Board.
- 7. The industry shall regularly send the process and washings & Scrubber effluents after treatment, to common pretreatment facility provided by Knowledge Square parks and incubators Pvt. Ltd., (Building 9000). After pretreatment, shall be lifted to CETP, JETL, Jeedimetla by duly complying with the inlet standards of the CETP prescribed by the Board.
- 8. The industry shall send the domestic effluents to Common Sewage Treatment Plant of Knowledge Square parks and incubators Pvt. Ltd.,(Building 9000). After pretreatment, the effluents shall be utilized for onland for gardening within the premises duly complying the standards stipulated by the Board.
- 9. The industry shall provide digital flow meters with totalizer for assessing the qualities of waste water disposed into common effluents collection tank of Knowledge Square parks and incubators Pvt. Ltd., (Building 9000) & shall maintain the register.
- 10. The industry shall suck the fumes emanated during the various chemical reactions in the fume hoods and pass them through a wet scrubber followed by Activated carbon adsorption system before letting into atmosphere through common stack.
- 11. The industry shall not discharge any waste water to outside the factory premises.
- 12. The industry shall not cause any air pollution/odour nuisance to the surrounding environment.
- 13. The industry shall not dispose the solid waste outside the factory premises.
- 14. The industry shall develop thick green belt all along the boundary of the unit and also in the vacant places with all tall growing trees with wide leaf area.
- 15. The industry should maintain the following records and the same should be made available to the Board Officials during the inspection.
  - a) Production details, RG-I records and Central Excise Returns.
  - b) Quantity of effluents generated and lifted.
  - c) Log Books for pollution control systems.
  - d) Daily solid waste generated and disposed.
- 16. The industry shall submit Environmental Statement in Form V before 30<sup>th</sup> September every year as per Rule No.14 of Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986.
- 17. The industry shall take all precautionary and safety measures during process operations.
- 18. The industry shall comply with all the directions issued by the Board from time to time.
- 19. This Order is issued to the industry without prejudice to the action taken by the Task Force of the Board.
- 20. The conditions stipulated in this order are without any prejudice to rights and contentions of this Board in any Hon'ble court of Law.

## SCHEDULE - C (See Rule 6(2))

(Conditions of Authorization for occupier or operator handling hazardous wastes)

- 1. The industry shall give top priority for waste minimization and cleaner production practices.
- 2. The industry shall not store hazardous waste for more than 90 days as per the Hazardous & other wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 3. The industry shall not sell the used empty drums / barrels / liners / bags / Bottle etc. to outside parties & vendors for reuse, instead they shall discard the same to avoid reuse, which is resorting in illegal dumping of Hazardous Waste and shall dispose the same directly to authorized recyclers only.
- 4. The industry shall ensure for proper labelling of Hazardous Waste / other waste containers with particulars of industry & type of Waste along with characteristics, while storage & transporting the waste to Recyclers / TSDF / Cement Industries.

- 5. The industry shall store Used / Waste Oil and Used Lead Acid Batteries in a secured way in their premises till its disposal.
- 6. The industry shall not dispose Waste oils to the traders and the same shall be disposed to the authorized Reprocessors/Recyclers.
- 7. The industry shall dispose Used Lead Acid Batteries to the manufacturers / dealers on buyback basis.
- 8. The industry shall take necessary practical steps for prevention of oil spillages and carryover of oil from the premises.
- 9. The industry shall maintain 6 copy manifest system for transportation of waste generated and a copy shall be submitted to Board Office and concerned Regional Office.
- 10. The industry shall maintain good housekeeping & maintain proper records for Hazardous Wastes stated in Authorisation.
- 11. The industry shall maintain proper records for Hazardous Wastes stated in Authorisation in FORM-3 and file annual returns in Form- 4 Rules 6(5), 13(8), 16(6) and 20(2) as per of the Hazardous & other wastes (Management, Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 12. The industry shall submit the condition wise compliance report of the conditions stipulated in Schedule B & C of this Order on half yearly basis to Board Office, Hyderabad and concerned Regional Office.
- 13. The industry shall dispose the e-waste to authorized recyclers / re-processors only.
