- 1. The industry shall pay balance consent fee of Rs. 6250/- within a week, if industry fails to pay, the CFO order stands cancelled
- 2. "The industry shall pay annual consent fee for every financial year (i.e., April to March) within the stipulated time period i.e., 1st quarter of every financial year (April June) is mandatory for the industry / project. Failing which, the validity of the Consent order automatically stands cancelled and operation of industry / project without valid Consent attracts penal action under the provision of Water & Air Acts." As per the Board Circular dated 10.05.2018, the consent fee shall be paid by the industry annually.
- 3. The industry has paid fee up to 31.03.2024. Thereafter, the industry shall pay annual consent fee for every subsequent financial year within 1st quarter (April June) starting from the year 2024 till the year 2038 for the investment as per the latest Balance sheet of the industry.

4. The industry shall take steps to reduce water consumption to the extent possible and consumption shall NOT exceed the quantities mentioned below

- 7. The industry shall comply with all the Rules and Regulations specified in Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974, Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and Hazardous and other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and their amendments issued thereof.
- 8. The industry shall use only virgin plastic as raw material.
- 9. The industry shall comply with Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 & amendments thereof.

- 10. There shall not be any effluent generation from washings. Only domestic effluents generation is permitted.
- 11. The industry shall not discharge any wastewater outside the premises under any circumstances.
- 12. The industry shall not dispose any solid waste outside the factory premises.
- 13. The industry shall dispose the discarded Plastic waste generated from the process only to the authorized re-cyclers /re-processors.
- 14. The industry shall take necessary measures to control fugitive emissions.
- 15. The industry shall take all precautionary and safety measures during process operations.
- 16. The industry shall not cause any odour nuisance to the surroundings.
- 17. The industry shall comply with all the directions issued by the Board from time to time.
- 18. The industry shall comply with the ambient air quality standards in respect of noise, as stipulated in the Environment (Protection) Rules, 1986.
- 19. Concealing the factual data or submission of false information / fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned in this order may result in withdrawal of this order and attract action under the provisions of relevant pollution control Acts.
- 20. The Board reserves its right to modify above conditions or stipulate any further conditions in the interest of environment protection.

(Conditions of Authorization for occupier or operator handling hazardous wastes)

- 1. The industry shall file annual returns in Form-IV as per the Hazardous and other Waste (Management &Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 2. Industry shall dispose / sell the hazardous wastes to only industries/ agencies authorized by State Pollution Control Boards. They shall verify the authorization of the Board given to the party before disposing their wastes to the external party.
- 3. The industry shall take all practical steps to avoid any spillage of effluents, waste oil hazardous chemicals & hazardous wastes on land.
- 4. The industry shall store the hazardous waste on a raised platform under a shell it is lifted to TSDF, Dundigal, Medchal-Malkajgiri District
- 5. The industry shall not store the hazardous waste in their premises for more than 90 days from the date of generation, as per the Hazardous and other Waste (Management & Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2017 and its amendments thereof.
- 6. Industry shall maintain 6 copy manifest system for transportation of waste generated and a copy shall be submitted to Board Office and concerned Regional Office.
- 7. The industry shall maintain the records of the Hazardous Waste in Form –III as per Hazardous and other Waste (Management &Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 8. The Industry shall submit the condition wise compliance report of the conditions stipulated in Schedule B and Schedule-C of this order half yearly basis to Board Office, Hyderabad and concerned Regional Office.
- 9. This consent is here by accorded subject to policy of the Government of Telangana State regarding relocation of the industry including modernization expansion thereof within ORR. If ordered the industry has to be closed or shifted as directed by the TSPCB.

SCHEDULE - D (See Rule 13(2))

[SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR REGISTRATIONAS PRODUCER UNDER PWM RULES, 2016]

- 1. Every producer shall, for the purpose of registration or for renewal of registration, make an application to the State Pollution Control Board or the Pollution Control Committee of the Union territory concerned, in Form I.
- 2. The industry shall not use sachets made by using plastic material for storing, packing or selling gutkha, tobacco and pan masala
- 3. The industry shall not supply plastic material/plastic rolls to any manufacturer/packing agency /distributor/trader etc., to pack gutkha, tobacco and pan masala;
- 4. The industry shall establish waste collection system based on "Extended producer's responsibility (EPR)" involving State Urban Development Departments, either individually or collectively, through their own distribution channel or through the local body concerned or engaging services of Waste Management Agencies. The industry shall apply for EPR registration through CPCB central portal for obtaining certificate for EPR implementation.
