1. In the reference cited, an application was submitted to the Board seeking Consent for Establishment (CFE) for expansion to setup R & D activity as mentioned below, with a proposed investment of Rs.73.53 Crores for Expansion.

As per the application, the above activity is to be located in the existing premises at Unit 101 to 118 in 1<sup>st</sup> floor & 201 to 205 & 209 in 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of SME Hub (Catalyst), IKP Knowledge park, Sy.No's 234/2, 234/3 & 235/2, Turkapally (V), Shameerpet (M), Medchal-Malkajgiri District with additional builtup area.
- 3. The above site was inspected by the Asst. Environmental Engineer-II, Regional Office, Medchal, T.G.Pollution Control Board on 26.07.2024 and found that the industry is surrounded by East: Phase- I Parking area; West: IKP Admin Building; North: Internal road of IKP; South: Internal road of IKP.
- 4. The Board, after careful scrutiny of the application, verification report of Regional Office, Medchal, recommendation by the CFE Committee meeting held on 03.08.2024 at TGPCB, Zonal Office, Hyderabad, hereby issues CONSENT FOR ESTABLISHMENT (CFE) for expansion to the industry, under Section 25 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 21 of Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and the rules made there under. This Order is issued to manufacture the products mentioned at para (I) only.

- 5. This Consent Order now issued is subject to the conditions mentioned in Schedule 'A' and Schedule 'B'.
- 6. This order is issued from pollution control point of view only. Zoning and other regulations are not considered.

### SCHEDULE - A

- 1. This order is valid for a period of <u>5 years</u> from the date of issue. Progress on implementation of the project shall be reported to the concerned Regional Office, T.S. Pollution Control Board once in six months. The consent of the Board shall be exhibited in the factory premises at a conspicuous place for information of the inspecting officers.
- 2. The proponent shall obtain Consent for Operation (CFO) from TGPCB, as required Under Sec.25/26 of the Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under sec. 21/22 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981, before commencement of the activity.
- 3. The proponent shall ensure that there shall not be any change in the process technology and scope of working without prior approval from the Board.
- 4. The industry is liable to pay compensation for any environmental damage caused by it, as fixed by the Hon'ble Courts, Collector and District Magistrate as Civil liability.
- 5. The rules and regulations notified under Environmental Acts by the MOEF&CC and by the Ministry of Law and Justice, GOI, regarding the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991 shall be followed.
- 6. Concealing the factual data or submission of false information / fabricated data and failure to comply with any of the conditions mentioned in this order may result in withdrawal of this order and attract action under the provisions of relevant pollution control Acts.
- 7. Notwithstanding anything contained in this consent order, the Board hereby reserves the right and powers under Section 27(2) of the Water (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and under Section 21 of the Air (Prevention & Control of Pollution) Act, 1981 and amendments thereof, to review any and/or all the conditions imposed herein, to modify conditions or stipulate any further conditions and to take action including revocation of this order in the interest of public health and environment.
- 8. Any person aggrieved by an order made by the State Board under Section 25, Section 26, Section 27 of Water Act, 1974 or Section 21 of Air Act, 1981 may within thirty days from the date on which the order is communicated to him, prefer an appeal as per the State Water Rules, 1976 and Air Rules, 1982, to such authority (hereinafter referred to as the Appellate Authority) constituted under Section 28 of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1974 and Section 31 of the Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act, 1981.

- 1. The industry shall not provide pilot plant activity and shall not go for commercial production without permission of the Board.

- 5. The industry shall send the process & washings effluents to common collection tank provided by M/s. IKP Knowledge Park. After pretreatment, treated effluents shall be sent to M/s. JETL, Jeedimetla for further treatment and safe disposal by M/s. IKP Knowledge Park, duly meeting the inlet standards of CETP as prescribed by the Board.
- 6. The industry shall send the domestic effluents to the common Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) provided by M/s. IKP Knowledge Park. After pre-treatment shall be used on land for gardening by M/s. IKP Knowledge Park within the premises duly meeting the prescribed standards of the Board.
- 7. The industry shall provide digital flow meter with totalizer for assessing the quantity of waste water disposed in to common effluent collection tank of M/s. IKP Knowledge Park and shall maintain the register.
- 8. The industry shall suck the fumes emanated during the various chemical reactions in the fume cupboards and pass them through a wet scrubber before letting into atmosphere through common stack.
- 9. The industry shall not discharge any waste water to outside the factory premises.

- Inorganic residues, failed batches and lift the waste as per the disposal option through M/s. IKP Knowledge Park.
- 12. The industry shall not discharge any waste water to outside the industry premises under any circumstances.
- 13. The industry shall not cause any air pollution/odour nuisance to the surrounding environment.
- 14. The industry shall not dispose the solid waste outside the factory premises.
- 15. The industry shall develop 33% of the total area as thick green belt all along the boundary of the unit and also in the vacant places with all tall growing trees with wide leaf area.
- 16. The industry shall comply with all the Rules and Regulations specified in Water (P&C of P) Act, 1974, Air (P&C of P) Act, 1981 and Hazardous and other Wastes (Management, Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.
- 17. The industry shall not manufacture any extra products or extra capacities without obtaining CFE/CFO of the Board.
- 18. The industry shall not take up trial production without obtaining Consent for Operation of the Board.
- 19. Rain Water Harvesting (RWH) structure (s) shall be established on the plant site so that the ground water is recharged by the storm water.
- 20. The following rules and regulations notified by the MoE&F, GoI shall be implemented:
  - a) Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016.
  - b) Construction and Demolition Waste Management Rules, 2016.
  - c) Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 & its amendments.
  - d) Battery Waste Management Rules, 2022.
  - e) E-Waste Management Rules, 2022.
  - f) Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 & its amendments.
  - g) Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 & its amendments.
- 21. The industry shall comply with Rules & Regulations notified by Ministry of Law and Justice, Govt. of India, regarding the Public Liability Insurance Act, 1991.
- 22. The industry shall comply with all the directions issued by the Board from time to time.
- 23. The Board reserves its right to modify above conditions or stipulate any further conditions and to take action including revoke of this order in the interest of environment protection.
- 24. This Order is issued to the industry without prejudice to the action taken by the Task Force of the Board.
