LOCAL RULES

Out of Bounds (Rule 27-1/B):

- · Any ball coming to rest outside the perimeter of the course.
- Any ball coming to rest in or on the "mausoleum" right of #16th Tee

Immovable Obstructions (Rule 24-2):

 All fixed sprikler heads, fairway distance markers, hazard stakes, advertisement hoardings, bore wells, switchboards, benches, dust bins, yardage markers, drainage chambers and protection screens are Immovable Obstructions.

Ground under Repair (Rule 25-1):

- · Casual water, bunker of fairway repair works are G.U.R.
- Play is prohibited within a G.U.R. demarcated area. If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.

Integral Parts of the course (Refer Rule 13-1):

 All roads and paths (with the exception of cemented roads) are integral parts of the course. All ramparts and walls within the course, and the Old mosque to the right of the 16th hole: the ball must be played as it lies or declared unplayable and Rule 28 applies.

Stones in Bunkers:

• Stones in bunkers may be removed and Rule 24-1 (Movable Obstruction): A player may take relief, without penalty, from a movable obstruction applies.

Sand under Cluster of Palm Trees:

 Sand under cluster of Palm Trees are not considered to be Sand Bunkers.

Temporary Obstruction:

• Any ball coming to rest in the fenced area in front of the 5th Back / Middle Tee Box is considered to be not in play & a relief must be taken from the drop zone near the white Tee box / free relief.

Play Prohibited

The following are "protected Areas". Entry into and play is prohibited.

The flower bed area in front of#14 and #15 tee box

If a player's ball lies in the area, or if it interferes with the player's stance or the area of his intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1 (Ground under Repair)

Environmentally-Sensitive Areas

The following are "Environmentally-Sensitive Areas". Entry into and play is prohibited.

- The STP tank area in front of Tee's #6, #10 and right of #17 green.
- If it is virtually certain that a ball has entered in an ESA, the player must, under penalty of one stroke, proceed under Rule 26-1 (Lateral water hazard).

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF LOCAL RULE:

Match play - Loss of hole; Stroke play - Two srokes.
