GHMC to build 50 theme parks in Hyd

Intending to enhance urban lung space, Greater Hyderabad Municipal Corporation (GHMC) has decided to construct 50 theme parks against an estimated cost of ₹123 crore.

Mayor Bonthu Rammohan, along with other city MLAs, on Wednesday laid the foundation stone for six such parks in Kapra circle, which will be constructed at a cost of ₹16.30 crore.

Speaking on the occasion, Rammohan said that as per directions of Municipal Administration and Urban Development minister K.T. Rama Rao different designs of theme parks are being developed for the benefit for all age-groups. These designs are inspired by those in New Delhi and Bengaluru.

“The theme parks will be developed with all facilities like space for yoga, walking track, open gym and other basic amenities. They will be developed in such a
